If the central heating or hot water is already on, the programmed off time is postponed. If they are off, it provides one, two or three hours of operation.

The British-made Honeywell ST6000 Series can control most home heating and hot water systems, from simple to sophisticated installations. At the top of the range is a versatile programmer that can provide independent time control of heating and hot water over either a seven day or five day/two day programme. The mid-range standard and mini-programmer models provide common time control of heating and hot water. The simplest models are single channel time switches for 24-hour and seven day operation that provide excellent value for controlling combi boilers and additional heating zones.

2-Honeywell ST6000: up to 3 extra hours heating at the touch of a button

In all models, each press of the “extra hour” button provides an extra hour of heating, up to a maximum of three hours.

Another button enables the current programme to be overridden and then reset automatically at the next programmed switching time.

All models feature large single buttons for all functions and a large clear LCD display which shows the time and AM or PM, the day (on seven-day models) and also when the extra hour or hours have been selected. All programming controls are covered by a hinged flap, leaving only the extra hour and override buttons uncovered for temporary alterations to the programmed times.
